I am writing this special welcome to say thank you to all our members here in Luton for their continued faithfulness and support to me and to the church. The two front offices were also remodelled to become the church reception and counselling and teaching rooms. ### Drop In Centre

The drop in centre is open to all comers wanting to know about Christianity and the church.

It is open for counselling, prayer and ministry. It will also have a dedicated prayer and teaching room where the School Of Applied Faith (SOAF) will be delivered.

**What is SOAF?** We pray for the sick and those with physical, emotional and mental needs but in the main church services this is more difficult because of the lack of time. At SOAF there will be time to teach and build up the faith of people and to pray for them. The majority of healing that took place in the bible came about because of people's own faith. "Faith cometh by hearing and hearing the word of God", wrote Apostle Paul.

The School Of Applied Faith will build people's faith for their own healing but also to help the believer practise faith to help a sick and troubled world. The more we know the more we will flow.
