ACA Local:

A key development strategy of the ACA has been to encourage fellowship amongst apostolic churches in a certain geographic area. Once fellowship has been established to use that strength and common vision to partner with local statutory agencies on the most urgent and practical issues affecting the local area. The peace and well-being of an area are the responsibility of the church. The church is according to our Lord: the light of the world, a city upon a hill so it's not to be hidden and the salt of the earth.

What initiatives, projects or programmes that are introduced will be different in each area for this is dependent on the particular needs and issues in the area.

In Luton, a number of apostolic churches under the umbrella of the ACA have been meeting in prayer every month for more than seven years. The pastors have got to know one another better and have become more than brothers or fellow ministers, but friends. Consequently, the churches have shared information about acquisition of property, church governance, not to mention supporting the main annual services.

This fellowship has enabled the ACA churches to meet regularly with senior police officers on a monthly basis to discuss local policing issues affecting the community, getting involved in the induction of new police officers in the town and providing support to individual officers who might be going through certain professional and personal issues.

As preachers and churches we know only too well the value of fellowship for it almost always lead to better understanding, working together and the advancement of the Kingdom of God.
