The West Croydon Congregational Church was built in 1886 to accommodate a congregation of 1, 000, It is, as Pevsner wrote, ‘Croydon’s most ambitious spire’.

In 1982, when the church was sold to the Oshwal Association for use as a Jain temple and community centre.

Having paid a deposit of £400,000.00 Apostolic Pentecostal Services have held since January 2017.
