Praise The Lord! Welcome to the Spring edition of **RRF E bulletin**; I trust you will find the messages, information and photographs interesting, stimulating and profitable.

Unlike Apostle Paul, who asked that the books and parchments he had left behind in Troas, together with his coat, be brought to him the next time Timothy came to visit him in prison, too many of us don't read and certainly not willing to write.

One project that is in progress is the production of a brief history of RRF in time for the main October Jubilee services. It is important that we chronicle history especially as we live it for its verbatim and therefore more credible and impactful.

We are called to be witnesses and there is no better story teller than people with firsthand knowledge of what took place. Furthermore, having more than one story teller makes the story more authentic because it can be checked and cross checked by the various witnesses.

Heaven invented writing and keeping of books. Throughout the bible, the greatest book of all on earth, we read on countless occasions of the work of scribes. The book of Revelation also tell us about the various books that were seen open in heaven from whence the saints would be rewarded and the sinner judged.

Let this article spur you, especially ministers, to read and write more than you have ever done before. Stop making excuses for not reading and for not writing.

The internet is awash with articles, books and reading materials on every subject imaginable. Some of these reading materials are dangerous and written to confuse, corrupt and deceive so it's even more important than ever before that the servants of God and the church write and make available good wholesome truth and sound doctrine.

Reading brings depth and breadth of knowledge. Listening brings the anointing. Watching brings emulation and implementation. Humble people also read for no one knows everything.

In 2 Timothy 4:13, as quoted above, Apostle Paul is in prison in Rome with by now no prospect of being released. In fact he knows his days are few for he knows he will

be executed. Yet he asks for the books so he could deepen his understanding and widen his knowledge. The parchments he would use to write down his thoughts for posterity.

Reading also enlarge our vocabulary, improve our spelling and writing skills, help us with pronunciation, as well as training the mind and keeping it occupied.

Teachers and preachers that don't read are often repetitive, shallow and boring. I have never read fully a novel nor a play not even William Shakespeare because I am not keen on imaginary stories however well written. So, I am not advocating one reads anything. Smith Wigglesworth a Pentecostal pioneer of the late 19th and 20th Century was illiterate in his young days and only learned to read and write in later life after being born again. He never read books, magazines not even newspapers. In fact he would not allow a newspaper in his home. Yet he was an avid reader of the Bible and it was very obvious whenever he got up to speak. He flowed in the word and in the Spirit for he was full of the word and faith.

Smith Wigglesworth once said about the importance of reading the scriptures: "It is as we feed on the Word and meditate on the message it contains that the Spirit of God can vitalise that which we have received, and bring forth through us the word of knowledge that will be as full of power and life as when He, the Spirit of God, moved upon holy men of old and gave them these inspired Scriptures".

Jesus aged 12 was in the temple reasoning with doctors of the law, scribes and scholars and they asked how he got such knowledge and understanding.

Finally, I pray I have stirred you to read and write and that you will do so this year starting today.
