Golden Jubilee a time of celebration and thanksgiving

A **golden jubilee** is a celebration held to mark a 50th anniversary be that: a marriage, years on the throne, independence of a country or appointed time of release from slavery.

From the beginning God wants men and women to be free; sadly we are inclined to enslave others. Nimrod pursued and enslaved others to serve him and his kingdom and to work on his ambitious project of building a tower to reach heaven. They were united in this cause and would do anything to succeed. God put a stop to their ambition by dividing their language into many thus creating confusion in communication. Good communication is essential in delivering a successful project and bad communication is a recipe for disaster.

The fall of man and his predilection to do evil also found a home amongst the Jews, God's chosen people, through whom the Messiah would come.

Through Moses, God regulated this practice, common amongst the nations, by ensuring the mistakes made by one generation did not carry over into other generations in perpetuity.

It's bad enough that my mistakes lead to my immediate family having to suffer but for future generations to be born into slavery with all its associated problems that would be too much.

Therefore, the year of Jubilee was instituted by Moses as directed by God. The Holy Bible provides the basis upon which the year of Jubilee should operate. In summary, the year of Jubilee had seven promises:

- 1. Liberty** – to the captive, family from a life of bondage, poverty and humiliation.
- 2. Possession** – personal and family property restored. One's name was also restored from that of a slave to a freeman, wife and family. Slaves were often kept apart for their very lives were owned by the slave master.
- 3. Restoration of Family** – its one thing to be brought into slavery but to be born as one is unacceptable to God.
- 4. Increase from the Field** – with restoration of land and property the former slave and family had hope for a better and brighter future so there was great incentive to work hard once released.
- 5. Freedom from Oppression** – the former slave could not forcefully be enslaved again, the law defended their liberty.
- 6. Safety** – the former slave was now free to travel without let or hindrance and safely. Moreover, they were entitled to the full protection of the law.

7. Blessings – God promised Israel overflowing blessings for forty nine years of enslavement is a very long time to be at such a huge disadvantage. The newly freed slave is promised extraordinary yield and favour.

The prophet Isaiah describes what Messiah would accomplish as the great liberator from sin and its concomitant issues (**Isaiah 61**). The gospel writers records the fulfilment of Messiah's mission both in the actual text but more so in his ministry here on earth.

In 1968 the Lord began a work which later would be named Restoration Revival Fellowship. Our mandate would be *“to build the old waste places and raise up the foundations of many generations; that thou shall be called, the repairer of the breach, the restorer of paths to dwell in”*. (**Isaiah 58:12**).

2018 is our Jubilee year and we give thanks to Almighty God for keeping us from the beginning until now, great has been His faithfulness.

We also thank Apostle GT Mullings, the late Prophetess C Flowers, Overseer LA Wilson, the late Pastor J Goddeti along with many others for their personal sacrifice, obedience and love for the ministry and the work over these 50 years.

In my forty plus years in the ministry I cannot recall a time more challenging than the last 18 months or so. However, the door is still open and God has not withdrawn His presence so let us “leave many things behind” be they good or evil.

Dwelling on the good things can lead to pride, complacency and inactivity. Dwelling on evil things leads to bitterness, strife and division. Instead let us “fight *the good fight of faith and lay hold unto eternal life*” for there is much more to be done so let it be the start of new things.

A brief history of RRF by Pastor J Mullings

What God Hath Joined

³ And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Genesis 12:3 (KJV)

The year 1968 was a year of turmoil and tumult around the globe. The cup of injustice, human tragedy, and sexual depravity was full. The years from 1966- 1968 are seen as the period in which the sexual revolution and the counter culture characterized by “free love”, communal living, and rock music hit its peak.

In the February of 1968, the horrors of the Vietnam War were uncovered, sparking a season of protests around the world. In April of the same year Dr Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated and in June Robert F. Kennedy suffered the same fate. It is not a coincidence that in the seasons where sin abounds the grace of God abounds much more. It is not a coincidence that at climax of tragedy and injustice that the cries of people desperate for God culminate in unique moves of God.

For one of my final dissertation papers I interviewed Prophetess Flowers for her perspective on the birth of Restoration Revival Fellowship. My sociological paper, brace yourself for this, set out to examine our fellowship against sociological definitions of a cult! Keen to demonstrate that when God divinely orchestrates the birth of a fellowship, that it defies these definitions and has genuine staying power.

Despite knowing the story fairly well from our annual anniversary meetings, interviewing Prophetess Flowers and recording her with consent, highlighted two key elements rarely dwelt upon, which I feel are right to bring to the fore at this time.

Prophetic direction – a result of consistent prayer

Before having even met Brother Mullings (now Apostle), Sister Clementine Flowers was holding house prayer meetings on a Friday nights for about a year. During the same period, Brother Mullings was being established as a travelling Evangelist with a healing ministry. The prophetic word that Sister Flowers received to go to Brother Mullings house on Uxbridge Road, without knowing which door to knock is both significant and miraculous; but I believe that there is greater significance in the joining of the prayer team of Sister Flowers and the Evangelistic team of Brother Mullings. Factor in one year of crying with the climax of what was happening in the world around and you will see the stage was set for another move of God.

2 Chronicles 7:14 (KJV)

This verse is prefaced with the Lord citing the condition of the world around Israel – “If I shut heaven”, said the Lord, and if there is locust or pestilence in the land. The state of the world and the cry of the church create a climate for revival.

When you know that prayer is the right thing to do; that the house of prayer for all people is not a building but your body; you store up the favour of God for that day when He looks down and says I've had enough.

⁹ Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them.

The Birth in Revival

In the October of 1968 revival broke out in the basement of Brother Mullings home when he accepted to host a prayer meeting that had been going on for a year. Starting a church did not even seem like a good idea to these pioneers, in fact it was not truly their desire. But the DNA of this fellowship is prayer and evangelism, and this is the combination that the Lord used to start revival. The Prophetic voice of God was important to this group of twenty-something – passions ran high but knowing the will of God was important.

It was said that some believed that the house should be treated as a filling station not a church. This was a concept going around at the time, that God would use the venue to fill people and send them on. But the Lord spoke to this group of young people.

Guiding prophetic utterances

#1 Seek not to establish yourselves for I will establish you in righteousness. Do not do after the works of those from which I have taken you out from and I will bless you!

#2 From this place Ministers will take the Gospel to different parts of the world!

#3 Every time we praise Him, He will do miracles amongst us!

It is important to note that due to the nature of the revival, that the two groups, both the prayer team and the evangelical team were disgruntled with the nearest churches to which they had joined themselves. This group had no presiding Bishop or founding Apostle. It had no upper hierarchy to lean on and they were mostly in their 20's.

The prophetic word to not do after the works of the places he drew them from had significance in both a doctrinal and organisational sense. It was a chance to start with a blank sheet. Over the years we were able to drop a number of false teachings and move into understanding foundational truths previously misunderstood or shunned by fathers in the flesh.

We were the church that did not take a lukewarm stance on Christmas. On Christmas day we would explain its pagan roots, tell people to come out of falsehood and the hypocrisy of interest of a baby in a manger. It didn't bother us, because we never felt it was our mandate to fit into a church system or wider societal norms.

God puts the answer in the house

When it came to comprehending the nature of God, rejecting triune theology, people must understand this was not derived in a theological debate. It was revealed in dreams and visions whilst our leaders were in separate locations. We were not brought together by theology; we were brought together by prayer. We didn't have an established council to determine our doctrine from Genesis to Revelation but we were a group growing in sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.

Prophetess Flowers returned from a mission to preach the oneness doctrine not knowing that while Apostle was away he too saw the truth. He also cites Bishop Anderson of Beulah Apostolic confirming that the Spirit of God is here but you need to go through "the waters of separation". The shift was complete when in a vision the Lord spoke to Apostle saying: "Why do you preach in my name, heal in my name, and baptize with the titles of deity?"

What no one knew is that Pastor Wilson was already baptised in Jesus name and in the absence of both Prophetess Flowers and Apostle Mullings, he was baptizing new converts in the name of Jesus!

Missions – to the families of the earth

Neither Apostle Mullings nor Prophetess favoured just ministering in the UK. The prophecy confirmed that God would send ministers into the world. The first major foreign mission came on the back of a prophecy in Hindi. It was Evangelist Graham who was speaking in tongues in the house when a visiting Hindi speaking man was in the midst. After crying out in Hindi that man asked her what is wrong. It turned out that in Hindi she was crying the word "Help! Help!"

It was not long afterwards arrangements were made for Prophetess Flowers maiden voyage to India.

When Prophetess shared the story of how the revival broke out in the basement the same power fell in the house of Pastor Joshua Goddeti. It is little mentioned but this group were already oneness believers. Today there are over 50 churches and more than 100 preaching points and over 10,000 baptised in the name of Jesus. While we

do not take over organizations, many have converted to the truth of the Baptism in Jesus name and oneness of God through the labours of Apostle Solomon and Moses Goddeti and Bishop Shastri.

In 1997 Pastor Denny was on a personal visit to Kenya when he heard a lone street preacher. He felt drawn to this man and approached him. That man is Apostle Wekesa, now leading 23 churches in Kenya and two in Uganda.

God's word has been fulfilled to us. There has not been a year without a miracle and in this we can say that the Lord has kept his word.

Families – A Gift to the Body

The journey of Restoration Revival Fellowship has been unorthodox by virtue of its birth and guiding prophecies. It is a miracle that with very high level organisation that we have churches in India and in different parts of Africa. But what has made this ministry strong is how the Lord moved in families. Saving one member and then capturing entire households, or a first, second and third cousin.

God promised Abraham that through him He would bless all the families of the earth. Our last five years have been extremely challenging. Whether the challenges results from the acquisition of premises, the death of key members and ministers or the migration of families I will not say but I suspect it's a combination of each of the above.

The breakdown of families in our church community is a challenge we must own at such a crucial time. Strong families make strong churches.

As a church with a legacy of close church family networks, raising our children together, educating them together, we have seen the possibility of raising the next generation of leaders almost prised from our grasp by a sustained spiritual assault on the truth, holiness, and our own ability to forbear in love. Yet with solid growth abroad and opportunity to build the kingdom at home and abroad we are in our 50th year looking to embrace a Jubilee that sparks a radical refocus and realignment. One that looks less at the past 50 years and more at the next 50 years, if the Lord tarries, in the knowledge that God has joined us to each other.
