A team left the UK to support the saints of RRF India and celebrate their Golden Jubilee. The team was led by the General Overseer, Apostle Mullings and included: Minister Pam Stewart, Min. Horace Clarke, Sister Andrena Clarke, Deaconess Pat Morgan, Mr William Flowers and Pastor Epie.

Pastor Epie left on the 19th of April while the rest of the team left on the 23rd of April. Pastor Epie's early trip was to visit Bishop Moses and the saints at Nasik. He had a lovely prayer meeting on the 20th with the young people at Nasik and encouraged them to move onto higher ground in Christ with the same zeal that he had witnessed at their first Youth Congress in 2007 at Mumbai. Some of the young people then are now in offices as youth pastors; what a blessing.

On Sunday morning the 21st April Pastor Epie attended morning service at Nasik while Bishop Moses made a round trip of six hours visiting another branch of the fellowship with three hours worship. Souls were saved and delivered at both services. We had another service at Pimplas in the evening, two and a half hours drive. Around 15 souls were saved that evening and we arrived back at home at 12.30 am.

The next day we headed for Kolpewadi after 3 hours drive and ministered to the saints under a tree canopy and then moved on to Shirdi, where a baby was dedicated after a night service. The Lord Jesus did great things and we were greatly encouraged.

We travelled down to Kalyan and met with the other team members on Wednesday the 24th of April. We had a meal with the brethren at Apostle Solomon's that evening. The hospitality and food were excellent, with great fellowship.

The next day we had another meal at Apostle Solomon's and had the first service in the evening. Some Pastors and saints had travelled for 24/36 hours to attend the Jubilee Service. The hall was full and there was great rejoicing with the out pouring of the Holy Spirit. We all felt at home with a great welcome, especially when William was introduced as the son of Mother Flowers. He described the experience as one of the best weeks in his life.

We had two services on the Friday and one whole day service on the Saturday. We were all given a chance to speak in the service. Some pastors who were leaders of organisations that had over 10, 000 members, spoke of the difficulties and challenges they had after coming into contact with the truth of the gospel. Since they left their organisation they have experienced tremendous growth in their personal life and ministry to the body.

The last day of the feast was held in Mumbai, because that was where Restoration Revival Fellowship India was born. We marched into the hall with the choir and pastors. It was a great reception. Different choirs sang and the General Overseer, Apostle Mullings, ministered on the mark of the beast. We were all honoured with anniversary gifts. Bishops Moses Goddeti and Shastri were ordained as Apostles, while Apostle Solomon was ordained as Chief Apostle. A large number of saints were recognised and awarded certificates for their faithful services. It was a glorious finale.

The team from London worked in unison and it was very encouraging seeing a lot of the youths we met in 2007, still zealous for the Lord and very active in service.

After a period of praise and worship led by Sister Namrata Goddeti, Minister Pam Stewart opened the session with a warm welcome to all sisters and mothers. The aim of the seminar was introduced, as an opportunity “to strengthen and encourage the women of God”.

Following a brief introduction we split into three groups, each with a facilitator (a UK sister) and an interpreter. Each group had a specific focus and target participants. The sessions were interactive and lasted for over 1 hour. Although the session was led by the facilitator, all sisters were able to share very personal testimonies and then consider these experiences in the light of the Word of God.

After the group sessions we returned as a whole group to complete the seminar in prayer one for another. We witnessed the Lord’s hand of deliverance on a new believer that was bound in idolatry, as He graciously poured out His Spirit in a marvellous way upon the women of God.
